- Circuit points are calculated 10-6-4-2-1-.5. Riders can earn extra points at our two designated Double Point shows. Points and standings will be updated online after each show.
- Leadline riders will receive a Circuit Achievement Award. Leadline riders who participate in a minimum 3 shows will be presented a special award at our Series Finale.

- ❖ No Circuit Fees for the Brookside Show Series Circuit Awards
- No schooling fees, but anyone riding in our schooling areas or schooling during the schooling break NOT planning to compete must still have a number and pay the Office/EMT fee.
- ❖ Must compete in at least 3 shows to be eligible for BSS Circuit Awards
- ❖ Office/EMT fee of \$15 will be applied to all entries





Held at Harrisbury Farm Show Complex 8/30-9/1, 2019

To qualify, a rider must be a member of a participating local horse show series. Riders - through their respective horse show series - accumulate points in their division or divisions beginning January 1, 2019 through August 14, 2019. Brookside's April, May, June, and July shows fall within the qualifying period. The top three riders from each division will be selected by their horse show series to show at the Colonial Classic.

***It is up to each rider to be familiar with the specs of their respective division at the Colonial Classic horse show. Specs for divisions at Brookside Show Series do not always match up exactly with the corresponding division at the Colonial Classic.
